Our activities and operations are designed to promote the development of young people who use the site as staff, volunteers or visitors allowing them to achieve their full physical, intellectual, social and spiritual potential as individuals, as responsible citizens and as members of their local, national and international communities.

Our first challenge was to purchase the freehold of the site, which we achieved in January 2008, purchasing the freehold for £1.2m. We raised this through fundraising and a bank loan and are now looking to pay off that debt and secure the funds that will enable us to add in new activities, build new facilities and improve our infrastructure, all of which will allow us to welcome more visitors to the site and increase our surplus. ## Longridge Development Plans

Longridge is entering an ambitious new stage of its development following the successful purchase of the site in 2008 from the Scout Association. We want to replace, upgrade and build new facilities in order to provide a truly 21<sup>st</sup> century water and land-based activities centre.

Cedar shingles, which provide an attractive and hard-wearing finish, will be incorporated into the 'Wave' design which will clad our new buildings.

The first of these is the training centre, building of which starts on site in September 2009. Names (and logos for companies) can be engraved onto a shingle. This will provide a permanent record of your support which will be visible to everyone who comes to the centre. It will also help in our fundraising from Trusts and Foundations, who often want to know that we have lots of supporters!
